This training course is for CURRENT or soon to be leaders in your troop who are 14 and younger. This training course is also for CURRENT or soon to be leaders in your venture crew who are 16 and younger and have never participated in a Boy Scout troop experience. Any exceptions must be approved by the S.E.A.L.S course director. Participants will be shown how to apply and use leadership skills and scout spirit effectively in a youth-lead troop in their specific leadership position.

To accommodate as many troops and crews as possible, each troop scoutmaster or venture crew advisor can submit 2 youth for this course, as well as 2 alternates. If the course is not full when open registration closes, alternates will be invited to complete the registration process and attend the course. Please do NOT pay for alternates until they are confirmed to attend the course.

Space IS limited and slots are filled on a first-come, first-served basis, based on when registration, payment, code of conduct, and medical form are received at the Council Service Center.

A mandatory scoutmaster meeting is held on Friday night from 7:30 – 8:30pm.

Equipment lists and detailed instructions for arrival are posted on the S.E.A.L.S. website and will be sent to scoutmasters and venture crew advisors upon their unit's registration at the Council Service Center.

Statement of Understanding

All S.E.A.L.S. course participants are selected to represent their local troops and councils based on their qualifications in character, camping skills, physical and personal fitness, and leadership qualities. S.E.A.L.S. course participants and their parents or guardians must read this Code of Conduct and Statement of Understanding, and the Scout must agree to abide by them as a condition of participation. Ultimately, each participant must be responsible for his own behavior, and any serious misconduct or infraction of rules and regulations may result in expulsion from the S.E.A.L.S. Course.

Code of Conduct

1. The Scout Oath and Law will be my guide throughout the S.E.A.L.S. course. I agree to obey the safety rules and instructions of all staff members.
2. I understand that S.E.A.L.S. adult leaders are responsible for the supervision of all staff and participants, and will maintain discipline, security, safety and adherence to the S.E.A.L.S. course Code of Conduct. I understand that all S.E.A.L.S. adult leaders will abide by the Scout Oath and Law and all U.S., state and local laws.
3. I will label all my personal items and leave valuable items at home. Neither S.E.A.L.S. course staff nor the BSA camp staff will be responsible for loss, breakage, or theft of personal items.
4. I will set a good example by keeping myself neatly dressed and presentable in the proper S.E.A.L.S. course uniform.
5. I will attend and participate in all scheduled programs and will cooperate with other S.E.A.L.S. course participants.
6. In consideration for other participants, I agree to follow the bedtime and sleep schedule of the course.
7. I will be responsible for keeping my tent and personal gear labeled, clean and neat. I will do my share to prevent littering of the BSA camp we are using.

8. I will demonstrate respect for S.E.A.L.S. course and BSA camp property and be personally responsible for any loss, breakage, or vandalism of property as a result of my actions.

9. I understand that the following behaviors are expressly forbidden and will be grounds for my immediate expulsion from S.E.A.L.S.:

- purchase, possession, or consumption of alcoholic beverages
- purchase, possession, or consumption of illegal drugs
- possession or use of firearms or dangerous weapons
- possession or detonation of fireworks
- theft
- intentionally threatening or injuring others
- intentionally damaging property

10. I understand that serious and/or repetitive personal behavior violations, including use of tobacco, cheating, stealing, possession of lasers of any type, gambling, dishonesty, swearing, fighting, cursing, hazing or any action which fails to show respect for an individual will result in my expulsion from the S.E.A.L.S. course.

11. I understand that serious violations of this code may result in expulsion from the S.E.A.L.S. course at my own expense. There are no refunds of course fees. All decisions by the Course Director are final.

NOTE 1: Alternates should NOT order or pay for any S.E.A.L.S. gear until invited to complete the registration process and attend the course.

NOTE 2: When specifying the size of belt, make sure to account for the length of the belt buckle. For example, if this belt is worn with the SEALS belt buckle, then the length of the belt ordered should be reduced by 2 inches. If you normally wear a 28" belt, then you would order a 26" belt if you intend to wear the SEALS belt with the SEALS belt buckle.

NOTE 3: A \$5 discount applies when the SEALS belt buckle is purchased along with the SEALS belt.

S.E.A.L.S. gear will be delivered at course check-in for course participants.

Participants from previous courses can pick up S.E.A.L.S. gear at Belk Scout Camp on the Saturday of the course.
